

CSR PROGRAMS OF NXTRA DATA LIMITED FOR FY 2025-26

1. Guild of Service (Acquisition of land and construction of a permanent Sannidhi Primary School in Najafgarh, Delhi)

The Guild of Service, North India was begun in 1972 as a branch of Guild of Service Chennai (established in 1923). In 2011, Guild of Service became a separate independent entity. There is in the Guild, the DNA of core grass root work combined with advocacy. Through its long journey, the Guild of Service understands that education of children, the differently abled and vocational education in collaboration with social welfare programs is the way for the underprivileged to become self-reliant and financially independent citizens. Over the years, the Guild extended its work to Jammu & Kashmir, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Delhi, Gujarat and Tamil Nadu, addressing unique challenges in each region, especially for underprivileged women and children.

The Guild is one of the few non-profit organizations that works on the ethos of volunteerism. The management comprises of professionals dedicating their time voluntarily to the cause of a just society. In line with this mission, we propose the acquisition of land and construction of a permanent Sannidhi Primary School in Najafgarh, Delhi. The school is founded on the ethos that economic stature should never be a barrier to quality education, and that being a non-profit institution must not justify below-par standards. Presently, the school is a rented set-up, offering classes up to Vth standard in English medium, serving primarily first-generation learners from migrant and daily-wage families. The gender ratio is balanced, with nearly equal participation of boys and girls. Education is holistic, secular and value based.

2. Satya Bharti Sr Secondary Scholarship program

The Satya Bharti Sr Secondary Scholarship program is a flagship initiative to support students from Satya Bharti Adarsh Senior Secondary Schools, who have completed Class XII, in pursuing higher education up to the Postgraduate level. These schools under the Bharti Airtel Foundation provide quality education free of cost from Kindergarten (KG) to Class XII to underprivileged children, ensuring equal access to learning and opportunities.

After Class XII, all the students are offered financial assistance to continue their academic path in Humanities and Commerce streams. This program aims to empower the underprivileged students from rural communities to achieve their career aspirations and contribute meaningfully to society.

Current Courses Covered

The scholarship supports a wide range of programs at Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) levels, including:

- Degree Programs – BA, B. Com, BBA, and related fields
- Professional Courses – Law, Management, Accounting, and similar streams
- Integrated Courses – Combined UG-PG programs in Humanities and Commerce
- Vocational / ITI / Diploma Courses – Minimum duration of two years
