The financial year 2024-25 concluded with commendable Safety performance, where our TRIR was 0.01 which is 97.5% below the target. We excelled in meeting our LTIFR targets, achieving 0.09 against a target of 0.30. Thank you for always working safely and exhibiting safe behavior at workplace which made Nxtra to achieve the target with such an exemplary performance. Let's continue to progress, taking one step up each time to elevate our performance to the next level. As this edition focuses on stepping up, we have also established our targets and goals for the year to elevate our EHS performance.

The year commenced with a Road Safety campaign promoting the theme of becoming a road safety hero. This campaign aimed to address major contributing factors to road accidents, including speeding, driving without helmets, and driving under the influence. In March, we proudly celebrated National Safety Week across all our PAN India locations, with enthusiastic participation from over 4,500 employees. From safety pledges and engaging awareness sessions to live demonstrations and interactive tool talks, each activity reinforced our shared safety culture. 

EHS Training Hours - Operations




Training & Awareness

National Road Safety Week (Jan 25)

As part of the 36th National Road Safety Week observed in January 2025, we conducted a comprehensive campaign across our PAN India locations to reinforce the importance of safe driving practices and road user responsibility where 2100+ participants got the insights. With the theme "Be A Road Safety Hero" the campaign aimed as a reminder of the shared responsibility we all bear in ensuring the well-being of ourselves and others while navigating the streets

One of the key highlights of the campaign was the Defensive Driving and Road Safety training delivered using Road Safety Awareness via VR & Simulator modules. This hands on experience allowed participants to simulate real-life road scenarios, helping them understand the consequences of distracted driving, speeding, and other unsafe behaviors in a controlled environment.













In addition to VR-based learning, multiple awareness drives, interactive sessions, and demonstrations were conducted to promote helmet usage, seatbelt compliance, pedestrian safety and responsible vehicle operation. The campaign saw enthusiastic participation from employees, drivers, and contract staff, making it a successful step toward building a safer road culture.

National Safety Week (Mar 25)

In March 2025, Nxtra Data Ltd proudly celebrated National Safety Week across all its PAN India locations, reinforcing our unwavering commitment to creating a safe and responsible work environment.
