## Details of change in the status/ development in relation to proceedings of material litigation

1.	Brief details of litigation	Bharti Telemedia Limited, a subsidiary of the Company, had filed appeals before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, against judgments of various High Courts which had upheld the competence of the State Governments to levy Entertainment Tax on DTH services.
2.	The details of any change in the status and/ or any development in relation to such proceedings	The Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide its judgment dated May 22, 2025, has dismissed the appeals filed by Bharti Telemedia Limited.  The total estimated exposure pursuant to the aforesaid judgement is ~INR 585 Crore which is fully provisioned in the books and against which INR 575 Crore has already been paid by Bharti Telemedia Limited. Bharti Telemedia is further examining the judgment and will decide the next course of action, if any.  The aforesaid judgment was received/ uploaded on website of Hon'ble Supreme Court on May 22, 2025 (around IST 1650 Hrs.) which can be accessed by clicking here.
