Brief details of litigation	The matter pertains to demand of Goods and Service Tax ('GST') by Additional Commissioner, Adjudication, Central Goods and Service Tax, Delhi ('GST Department') under reverse charge mechanism on License Fee ('LF') and Spectrum Usage Charges ('SUC') basis the demand note issued by Department of Telecommunications. The total demand assessed by the GST Department was INR 604.66 crores.
2.	The details of any change in the status and/ or any development in relation to such proceedings	On an appeal filed by the Company to Commissioner (Appeals), Central Goods and Service Tax Appellate Authority, Delhi ('Appellate Authority'), the Appellate Authority has passed an appeal order reducing the said demand to INR 194 crores. The physical copy of the Appeal Order was received on August 21, 2024 (at around IST 1900 Hrs). The Company is assessing the impact of the appeal order and shall take appropriate action(s).
