Airtel to exit the Ghanaian telecom market

New Delhi, October 27, 2020: Bharti Airtel Limited ("Airtel") in its Board Meeting held earlier today announced the approval of the Board for concluding an arrangement with the Government of Ghana wherein Government of Ghana will acquire 100% shares of Airtel Ghana Limited ('AirtelTigo' or the 'Company') along with all customers, assets and agreed liabilities.

The parties are in advance stages of discussions for conclusion of the commercial agreement for the transfer of AirtelTigo on a going concern basis to the Government of Ghana. Accordingly, Airtel is voluntarily taking an impairment charge of INR 1,841 Mn.

AirtelTigo is a joint venture between 'Airtel' and 'Millicom' wherein Airtel holds a non-controlling 49.95% share in AirtelTigo.
